How does Dallas' brush and bulk garbage collection work?

Brush and bulk garbage are collected once a month by the City of Dallas Sanitation Services department, on a weekly schedule.

To find out your week of collection, see the map in this brochure and count the Mondays on your calendar. There are NO collections in the weeks for the months that have five Mondays.

Brush and bulk trash items must be placed out by **7:00 a.m. on Monday** of the scheduled collection week.

The earliest brush and bulk garbage items **can be placed out is the Thursday before** the scheduled collection week. See the schedule in this brochure for dates.

What items are collected?

- Large limbs
- Shrubby
- Bagged leaves
(in sealed 50-gallon or smaller bags)
- Furniture
- Appliances
- Carpet
- Mattresses and box springs

Brush **must** be separated from bulk garbage.

What items are NOT collected?

- New construction debris*
- Remodeling debris*
- Bricks, concrete, rocks and dirt**

- Grass clippings. Grass clippings are only collected during "scalping season" from March to April. Bagged grass must have a special tag to be collected. Whenever practical, grass clippings should be reused on your lawn.

***Cost Plus** service is available to retrieve construction or remodeling materials, or if you missed the bulk collection pick-up. Call 3-1-1 for a free Cost Plus estimate.

**Bricks, concrete, rocks and dirt are not available for bulk garbage or Cost Plus collection. These items must be taken to McCommas Bluff for disposal.

Where and how should items be placed?

Brush and bulk garbage items must be placed **at the curb in front of your home** for collection.

Do not leave cars parked in front of brush/bulk trash items between 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. during your collection week.

Brush and bulk garbage should not be placed near or over a utility meter or fire or water hydrant.

Brush and bulk garbage should not be placed against utility poles or traffic signs.

Brush and bulk garbage should not be placed onto vacant lots or center medians.

How is storm debris collected?

If a storm causes widespread damage, Sanitation Services will declare a storm debris collection period and provide an estimated date for cleanup, along with other instructions and residents. Estimated dates for collection are subject to change and depend on the actual amount of damage caused.

If the situation warrants, Sanitation Services will hire contract crews to help collect storm debris.

Residents impacted by storms should set debris out for collection as soon as possible after the storm event.

Unless notified otherwise, City crews will maintain their regular brush and bulk garbage collection schedule during storm collection events. So if the storm hits - for example - during Week 2 of the month, crews will begin their collection in the Week 2 areas where they have not yet picked up before moving to Week 3, Week 4, and so forth. If necessary, additional "passes" will be made through areas during the storm debris collection period.

The City will post Storm Debris Collection maps on its Web site to show where Sanitation crews are currently working and which areas are next.

The City's Code Compliance Services staff will not issue citations for out-of-cycle brush during a designated storm debris collection period. However, once the storm clean-up is complete, Code will resume issuing citations for out-of-cycle brush set outs.

WARNING

Brush and bulk garbage placed out for collection outside your designated collection week is subject to a citation and fine of up to \$2,000. Warnings are not issued for out-of-cycle placements. **Residents can be given citations for the first occurrence.**

Residents who wish to transport their own brush and bulk garbage or storm debris to McCommas Bluff may do so in cars. You must show proof of Dallas residency (drivers license or utility bill and photo ID).
